**St. Patrick Parish Elevator Project**

*Dear Parish Family,*

The "Rooted in Faith, Forward in Hope" initiative was undertaken by the Diocese of Cleveland and managed by the Catholic Community Foundation here at St. Patrick Parish in 2012. This campaign has taken place in every parish in the Diocese of Cleveland. Its purpose was to raise 125 million dollars for the benefit of the Diocese-at-large and St. Patrick Parish in particular. St. Patrick's, as you may remember, was given a goal \$270,000. Through your generosity, we reached 202% of that goal in pledged support. 30 % of all monies pledged up to the goal came back to St. Patrick's. 70% of all monies that were raised after that goal was achieved have come back to St. Patrick's.

We told the C.C.F. that we wished to address three areas. First, we wished to resurface the parking lot. This was done. Second, we wished to enhance the pastoral life of the parish. This was primarily done through the hiring of a full-time, Certified Lay Ecclesial Minister, a part-time, Religious Education coordinator and by enhancing our technology here at the parish.

The third and most ambitious goal was to provide access to the lower hall for those unable to negotiate the stairs. In speaking with Bishop Lennon and representatives of the Diocesan Legal office and Finance office, an agreement was reached. Mr. Alex Nameth, a life-long parishioner at St. Patrick Parish, had requested that, upon his death, all his assets be distributed to the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland "for the benefit of the Parishioners of St. Patrick's Church." These wishes were made known through a Declaration of Trust dated July 26, 2011.

When I came to St. Patrick's as Administrator in January 2012, we owed the Diocese of Cleveland approximately \$280,000.00 in unpaid assessments. We have paid our monthly assessments every month since then. This amounts to roughly 16.5% of our monthly income from the Regular Sunday collection. By agreement with the Bishop, we were able to pay half of our outstanding assessment balance. This came to approximately \$140,000.00. Some of the money used for this came from the Nameth estate. In return, the Bishop would allow us to proceed with construction of an elevator.

After a lengthy period of consultation with the Parish Pastoral and Finance Councils, several bids were solicited for the purpose evaluation. As this process unfolded, the remaining assets from the Nameth estate came to the parish along with funds from "Rooted in Faith, Forward in Hope." Alex also stipulated that a St. Patrick Parish family (who served as Successor Trustees) would be allowed to purchase his property and real estate at a price of 80% of the fair market value established by a certified real estate appraiser. This did, in fact, take place. This represented approximately \$259,000.00.

In addition, the family also added an additional sum so to make for the remaining 20% of the fair market value as well as some other items sold from his estate. This came to approximately \$55,000.00. All the money was then moved from the Nameth Trust directly to St. Patrick Parish for the expressed purpose of funding the elevator project.

On August 10, 2016, St. Patrick Parish received permission from Bishop Lennon to move forward with the installation of an elevator for access to the lower Church Hall. This was done in consultation with the Diocese of Cleveland Facilities Services Corporation, which is the chief adviser to the Bishop and to the parishes on all matters relating to capital projects and parish plant maintenance.

**St. Patrick Parish Elevator Project (cont)**

On Monday, September 12, 2016, work will begin on this project. The elevator will provide access to the ground level, to the main body of the Church and the lower Church Hall. It will serve three levels and will be enclosed and will require an extension outward of a small portion of the west wall of the Church. The General Contractor is Crombie Construction Management Ltd. of Chardon, Ohio.

I will be placing displays in the back area of the Church that will show what it will look like when it is finished. The quoted price for this project is \$ 258,898.35.

We currently have approximately \$825,000.00 in our primary account with First Merit. Our next major project will be to reconstruct the entire front portico and, in all likelihood, remove/fill in the garage underneath the portico. We are also looking to switch to natural gas and, hence, remove the need for the oil tank currently in that garage. This would also entail a new, far more efficient furnace.

As with any capital project exceeding \$25,000.00, at least three bids must be obtained, submitted to the Diocese of Cleveland Facilities Services Corporation and the Bishop. Finally, the Bishop must have final approval. This is Diocesan policy.

I would like to thank you once again for your generous support of St. Patrick Parish. Please know that you and your loved ones are in my prayers each day.
