NOVEMBER 6, 2016: THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parish Family,

The Resurrection of the dead and life everlasting form the common themes of this Sunday's first reading and Gospel reading. Second Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14, tells us of how seven brothers and their mother refused to betray God's Law given through Moses. They were willing to suffer torture and death as they believed that they would be raised up "to live again forever." In the holy Gospel according to Luke (20:27-38), Jesus is confronted by the Sadducees, who deny that there is a resurrection. Jesus reminds them that the dead will rise and that the God whom they worship "is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive." Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life.

As I mentioned in last week's bulletin, Bishop Lennon has named Fr. Kawalec to serve as the new Pastor of Nativity of the Lord Jesus parish in Akron, effective January 1, 2017. We will be having a farewell reception for him on Sunday, December 11th, in the Church Hall after the 9:30 a.m. Mass. Fr. Kawalec will have the 9:30 a.m. Mass that day. Please mark your calendars and take this opportunity to thank Fr. Kawalec for his dedicated, priestly service to our parish family.

I am pleased to report to you that the Bishop has also assigned Fr. Ed Janoch to serve as our new Parochial Vicar, effective January 1, 2017. Both he and I will continue to serve both St. Mary's and St. Patrick's. Fr. Janoch was ordained in 2000 and has served in a number of parishes throughout our Diocese. Please keep both Fr. Kawalec and Fr. Janoch in your prayers during this time of transition.

As we approach Veterans Day this week, I would encourage you to pray for our service men and women in our Armed Forces. As we give thanks for all those men and women who served our nation, we know that many continue to serve in dangerous and difficult circumstances. May God bless them and keep them safe so that they may return home to their loved ones.
