**Change the Batteries in your Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors**

The Thompson Township Fire Department is reminding the public that with the end of daylight saving time it's time to change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors. While changing your batteries check the back of each smoke or CO detector for the manufactured date, any detector older than 10 years should be replaced. Remember that hardwired smoke detectors also contain a backup battery that requires replacement.

**Smoke detectors save lives.** Unfortunately, almost two-thirds of all fire deaths occur in homes where there is no working smoke detector and you are twice as likely to perish in a fire if you don't have a working smoke alarm. Save a life - Test your smoke alarm, replace batteries and keep them connected!
