

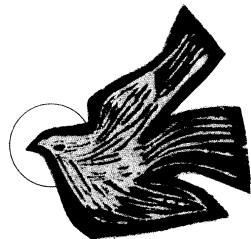
Chili Cook-Off : Saturday January 28 at 5:00 PM**Winter Warm

Confirmation for Adults

Adult Catholics (ages 18 and older) who have been baptized, received First Eucharist and are practicing their faith but have not celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation are invited to participate in preparation sessions for adults on February 9 and 23, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM.

Confirmation is the third Sacrament of Initiation in the Catholic Church. Confirmation is required for one to serve as a Godparent or as a Confirmation Sponsor, and is highly recommended prior to marriage in the Church.

Why does one need Confirmation? Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- ◇ *it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation [becoming adopted sons and daughters of God] which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!"*
- ◇ *it unites us more firmly to Christ;*
- ◇ *it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;*
- ◇ *it renders our bond with the Church more perfect;*
- ◇ *it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross.*

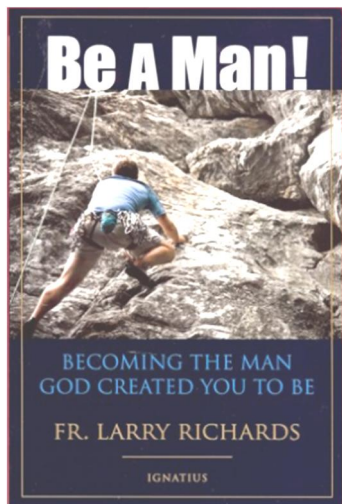

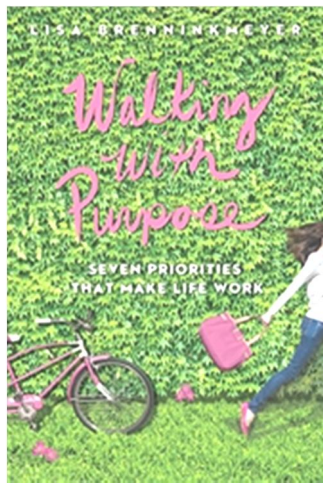
