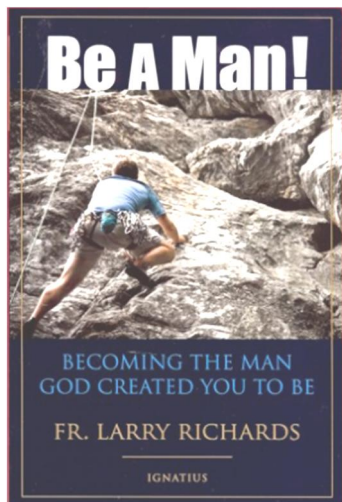
Catholic Men's Fellowship of Northeast Ohio: Saturday, March 25th, 2017

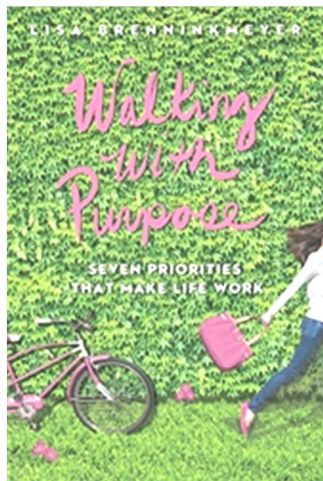
