**APRIL 9, 2017: PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF OUR LORD**

*Dear Parish Family,*

This is Holy Week. The celebration of Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the most sacred week of the year for Christians around the world. The events that led to our redemption are celebrated by the Church in her Sacred Liturgy. In addition, many people around the world are preparing for the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil Mass.

I would encourage you and your loved ones to fully participate in the celebrations of Holy Week. As we recall how the crowds welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem, we also know that some of them would be calling for his crucifixion five days later. The liturgies of Holy Week are meant to help us reflect more deeply on the price that was paid for our salvation.

On Tuesday of Holy Week, the Chrism Mass will take place at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Cleveland. This Mass is where all the sacred oils used by parishes throughout the Diocese are blessed by the Bishop. On Wednesday evening, we will have our annual Tenebrae service. This prayer service is an ancient liturgy that draws heavily upon the Lamentations of Jeremiah and leads us into the Easter Triduum.

On Holy Thursday, we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. This Mass recalls the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood at the Last Supper. We will also have the Washing of the Feet in imitation of our Blessed Lord. On Good Friday, we will celebrate the Lord's Passion with the Veneration of the Cross and the distribution of Holy Communion. We will also offer the Stations of the Cross. On Holy Saturday, we will have the traditional blessing of the Easter baskets. On Holy Saturday night, the Church will be illuminated with light after beginning in darkness. The Easter Vigil Mass will usher in the Easter Season and lead us into the joy of Easter Sunday.

I pray that God will bless you and your loved ones with a prayerful Holy Week and a blessed Easter.
