*Dear Parish Family,*

I would like to thank all those who helped to make the blessing of our new addition such a wonderful celebration last Sunday. We are so blessed to have many generous souls here at St. Patrick's. My special thanks goes out to all those whose generosity made the project possible. Because of their generosity, all have access to the Church, the ground level and the Church Hall.

Our next major projects entail converting our heating system to natural gas and addressing the front portico. I will keep you informed of these projects as they progress. We have received the Bishop's approval for the conversion project and are in the planning stage for the portico project. We have engaged Smollen Engineering to advise the most cost effective repair and re-design of the portico, meeting current building codes. Please feel free to e-mail your suggestions to me as we work to complete these important projects.

As we move toward the end of the fiscal year on June 30<sup>th</sup>, I am happy to report that our financial position is very strong. A complete financial report will be made available to the parish later this summer, per Diocesan guidelines.

With regard to parish finances, I would like to share with you some changes that will be taking place. Justin Turk, who has served as our parish Bookkeeper since January 2012, will be stepping down from that position. Justin works full-time in the Finance Office of the Diocese of Cleveland. He has been a great blessing for our parish and I am very grateful for his service to our parish family. I wish him all the best and I pray that God will abundantly bless him and his family in the years ahead.

I am happy to report that Linda Ropchock will be assuming the responsibilities of Bookkeeper, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>. Linda is an active, long-time parishioner here at St. Patrick's. As she serves as Bookkeeper here at St. Patrick's, she will also continue in her role as Business Manager at St. Mary's in Chardon.

I would ask that you keep both Justin and Linda in your prayers during this time of transition.
