*Dear Parish Family,*

*I would like to thank all those who served free hot dogs and beverages at the St. Patrick Parish tent at Thompson circle on the fourth of July. Our parish was once again represented very well in our community. The day was sunny and beautiful and our nation's birthday was observed for the 241st time.*

*In the Gospel for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Matt. 11:25-30), Jesus says, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."*

*During these summer days, many families will take a much needed summer vacation. It is good to get away and spend quality time with loved ones and allow ourselves to be renewed and refreshed. This kind of rest, while very good indeed, will inevitably come to an end.*

*Jesus wants to give us rest that will endure. It is a rest that comes from the Prince of Peace Himself. It is not a rest from our daily duties, but rather the peace that no one and nothing can ever take away. It is the very Peace of Christ that abides in our hearts regardless of how busy we are. This peace is one of the Fruits of the Holy Spirit described by St. Paul in his letter to the Galatians (5:22-23). It flows from a deep and abiding love for God and the knowledge that one is loved unconditionally by God. It flows from a committed prayer life and shows itself in the words and deeds of a true disciple of Christ.*

*Perhaps St. Paul sums it up best in the Second Reading for this Sunday's Mass. In his letter to the Romans (8:9-11,13), he says, "You are not in the flesh; on the contrary, you are in the Spirit, if only the Spirit of God dwells in you."*

*The person who experiences the peace of Christ becomes a source of peace to others. During these summer days, let's never forget who the Source of Peace truly is. As St. Paul states in the Second Reading, He is "the Spirit of the One who raised Jesus from the dead." Amen.*
