**AUGUST 13, 2017: NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*To my brothers and sisters in Christ:*

This Tuesday is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is one of the Holy Days of Obligation that is celebrated by the Catholic Church in the United States. This Solemnity is one in which “Mary’s assumption into glory foreshadows our own entry, body and soul, into heaven for all eternity.” This day is to celebrate Mary’s reward for her faithfulness to answering God’s call for her to be the mother of His Son, Jesus the Christ.
