**AUGUST 27, 2017: TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*Dear Parish Family,*

The Parish Pastoral Council is a group of parishioners who serve both as representatives of the parish-at-large and as advisors to the Pastor on matters pertaining to the pastoral life of the community. As stated by “*Christ Calls Us Together*” (Parish Pastoral Council Policy for the Diocese of Cleveland dated November 25, 1990):

*The parish does not exist for itself, but to carry forward the work of the Church which is the mission of Jesus. The parish has two basic purposes: (1) to support the spiritual growth of its members through proclaiming the Word, building up the community, celebrating the liturgy, and serving all God's people; and (2) to enable the members to participate actively in the priestly, prophetic and royal mission of Jesus to the world. (CCUT, p. 4)*

Each parish of the Diocese of Cleveland is required to have a Parish Pastoral Council. Once again the document “*Christ Calls Us Together*” states:

*In virtue of his office, the Pastor presides over the Parish Pastoral Council. As President, the Pastor fully participates in the deliberations of the Parish Pastoral Council and is involved completely in the planning and policy development. The Pastor is responsible for the final approval of Council recommendations concerning pastoral plans and policies as well as for the implementation by parish Staff and other groups. The Parish Pastoral Council is a consultative body which unites laity and clergy in a community of prayer, leadership, service and pastoral planning. All Councilors work together as they seek to listen to the Holy Spirit in discerning what is best for the parish in the light of the Gospel, the Church's teaching, and the experiences and needs of parishioners and the surrounding community. The Council can fulfill its role by encouraging a climate in which people can feel free to speak the truth with openness and love. (CCUT, p. 11)*

The Pastor is to consult the Parish Pastoral Council on matters of major pastoral concern. In the weeks to come, there will be information in the bulletin regarding the PPC here at St. Patrick's and an opportunity to nominate individuals (including yourself) who might wish to serve on the Council.
