Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension. Jesus tells his disciples to “Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned (Mark 16:15-ff).” After our Lord was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God, the disciples “went forth and preached everywhere...”

2000 years later, the Church continues to proclaim the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. As she does so, there is always a great need for more workers in the Lord’s vineyard. The disciples looked up at the sky, but eventually they would have look to one another and to the mission they’d been given.

The Lord continues to call His people to service. In particular, I would highlight the great need that exists for more men to respond to God’s call to serve as Priests. The Diocese of Cleveland is very blessed to have its own seminary for Diocesan Priesthood. While our numbers are better than many, larger dioceses, a significant number of Priests will be retiring in the next few years. In short, more and more priests will be asked to serve parishes alone or serve more than one parish.

Let us pray that more young men will hear the call to embark on the great adventure of discipleship as Priests and Religious. Let us also pray that more young women will respond generously to the call to serve as religious sisters.
