May 27, 2018 THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is the central dogma of our Catholic – Christian faith. We believe in one God in Three Persons: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.

Christians do not worship three different Gods, but one, single Being that is threefold and yet remains one. We know that God is triune from Jesus Christ: He, the Son, speaks about His Father in heaven (“I and the Father are one,” John 10:30). He prays to Him and sends us the Holy Spirit, who is the love of the Father and the Son. That is why we are baptized “in the name of the Father and of the son and of the Holy Spirit” (Matt 28:19).

The fact that there are three persons in one God is a mystery. We know only through Jesus Christ that God is Trinitarian (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #237). God is all-powerful and all-knowing. At the same time, God is closer to us than we are to ourselves, as some spiritual writers have put it. Indeed, God became Man, while remaining truly God, in the person of our Lord Jesus Christ. God did this so as to redeem us and save us from the power of sin and death.

As we celebrate this Solemnity, let’s take special notice of something we do each time we enter the Church. As we bless ourselves with holy water from the font, we are making a statement of faith. This is no, simple, ordinary statement. Rather, it is a profound statement of our belief in the one, true God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Furthermore, it is a statement of our belief in the Incarnation and the power of baptism.

May the perfect communion of the Most Holy Trinity always be a source of unity for our families and for our communities as a whole.
