June 3, 2018 THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (a.k.a. Corpus Christi). "At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood. This he did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he should come again, and so to entrust to his beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of his death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.'" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1323)

(CCC, #1324) The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."

(CCC, #1325) "The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit."

(CCC, #1326) Finally, by the Eucharistic celebration we already unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipate eternal life, when God will be all in all.

(CCC, #1327) In brief, the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our faith: "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking."

The supreme privilege of the Priesthood is to offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The Mass is the re-presentation to God the Father of the Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary. We, in turn, unite our imperfect selves to that perfect Sacrifice at every Mass. The Mass, therefore, is the greatest and most powerful prayer of the Church.

It is imperative that we never take this awesome gift for granted. As we look upon the consecrated host and the chalice at the elevations, let's echo the words of St. Thomas upon seeing the Risen Christ with his own eyes: "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28).
