This is also true in the wider culture where many wish to re-define traditional understandings of marriage, family life and gender identity.

Bless these men, that they may be strengthened as Christian fathers. Let the example of their faith and love shine forth. Grant that we, their sons and daughters, may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect.

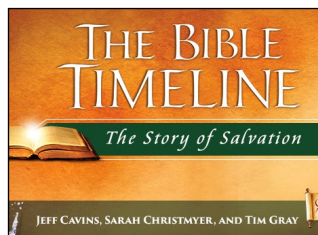
