**June 24, 2018 THE NATIVITY OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST**

*Dear Parish Family,*

The Gospel reading for the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time is from Mark 4:35-41. The disciples and Jesus are crossing the Sea of Galilee in a boat when “a violent squall” threatens to fill their boat with water. The disciples are “terrified” while our Lord is “in the stern, asleep on a cushion.” They woke him and Jesus proceeds to rebuke the wind and say to the sea, “Quiet! Be still!” “The wind ceased and there was great calm.”

Our Lord’s words to the disciples can be asked of us today – “Do you not yet have faith?” When the storms of life come our way, do we find that ourselves in a state of fear and anxiety? By contrast, are we able to allow the peace of Christ to lead us to a place of quiet and stillness of spirit?

The wind and the sea obey the Lord. If we believe this to be true, how much more will he care for us for whom he suffered, died and rose from the dead. As St. Paul reminds us today in his second Letter to the Corinthians (5: 14-17), “So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come.” Amen.
