

Beginning with the first weekend of September - for our petitions at Mass and our listing in the bulletin - we will start with a 'clean slate'. Names will be placed on the prayer list for a period of two (2) months - unless you notify us sooner to remove a name. At the end of the two month period, from when the name first appeared, the name will be removed. Please call us to renew a request for another two months as necessary. We'll see how this works, knowing we may need to 'fine tune' this procedure as we go forward.
