Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, we will be celebrating the Anointing of the Sick at all the Masses. This sacrament of healing is for all Catholics who struggle with serious, acute or chronic illness. The Oil of the Sick is applied by the Priest to the forehead and palms of each person.

First he anoints the head, saying:

“Through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit.”

Then he anoints the hands, saying:

“May the Lord who frees you from sin, save you and raise you up.”

As I reflect on over 22 years of Priestly ministry, some of the most poignant moments occurred when celebrating this sacrament. This is especially true when the person being anointed is nearing the end of their life on this earth. It is also special for the family members gathered around a loved one who is near death. Our faith and this sacrament serve to remind us that our lives are but a pilgrimage whose ultimate destination is, for those who know, love and serve God, the heavenly kingdom.

I would also like to thank all of you who have prayed for Fr. Janoch during his medical leave of absence since late November 2017. I spoke on the phone with the Vicar for Clergy and Religious, Fr. Dan Schlegel, this past Friday. He shared with me that Fr. Janoch is doing well and should be returning to active ministry sometime this month. While Fr. Janoch would certainly be welcomed back here at St. Mary's and St. Patrick's, both he and his caregivers believe that a new assignment would be in his best interest. He will, therefore, be moving on to a new assignment in the Diocese of Cleveland.

For the time being, both parishes will continue on without an assigned Parochial Vicar. I have been assured by Fr. Schlegel that we will be assigned a Parochial Vicar by June 2019, at the latest.

I ask that you continue to keep Fr. Janoch in your prayers during this time of transition. Please be assured of my prayers for you and your loved ones.

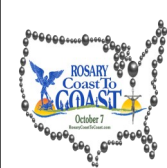
PSR News
