We see in much greater detail our own need for God’s forgiveness and healing. We see how futile it is to close our eyes to injustice and the suffering of others. Bartimaeus cried out “all the more” when told to be quiet by those around him. **May we never cease asking God for the grace to be ever faithful to Him.**
