On the Feast of the Epiphany, Catholic families around the world gather to ask God's blessing on their homes; and on those who live in, or visit a home. It is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in our home, our comings and goings, our conversations, our work and play, our joys and sorrows. A traditional way of doing this is to use blessed chalk to write above the home's entrance the following:  
**20 + C + M+ B + 19** The letters C, M, B have two meanings:

- They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar.
- They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless the house."  
 The "+" signs represent the cross and 2019 is the new year.

We invite you to adopt this custom in your family. Please take the package of blessed chalk and the prayer of blessing from the back of church for use in your home, or re use the one you saved from last year.
