This Sunday is the Fifth Sunday of Lent. The Gospel reading from John (11: 1-45) takes us to Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. Lazarus, their brother, dies. Jesus, “the resurrection and the life,” raises him from the dead. Jesus commanded them to “take away the stone.” The Lord Jesus can remove the stones from our hearts. There are stones that weigh us down and hinder us from following Christ more fully and completely. They may be stones of resentment, regret, fear, unhealthy anger or any number of things that prevent the light of Christ from shining through us.

As we move toward the final days of Lent, let’s allow the light of Christ to shine brightly through us by allowing our Lord to take away the stones from our hearts.
