Dear Parish Family,

Happy Father's Day!

This Sunday is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. It is the central doctrine of our faith that we believe in one God, who is three divine persons – God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. This Solemnity always occurs on the Sunday following Pentecost Sunday. Whenever we make the Sign of the Cross or bless ourselves with holy water, we are expressing this central truth of Catholic-Christian faith. If a person denies this reality, then he/she does not possess a Christian faith.

Let's pray that our homes and communities become ever more receptive to the one, true God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This Trinitarian hymn (Phos Hilaron) was written in Greek in the third century. We know it today as "O Radiant Light, O Sun Divine":

*O radiant light, O sun divine,
 Of God the Father's deathless face,
 O image of the light sublime
 That fills the heavenly dwelling place.
 Lord Jesus Christ, as daylight fades,
 As shine the lights of eventide,
 We praise the Father with the Son,
 The Spirit blest and with them one.
 O Son of God, the source of life,
 Praise is your due by night and day;
 Unsullied lips must raise the strain
 of your proclaimed and splendid name.*
