Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday marks the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time and the Gospel reading is from Luke 10:25-37. Our Blessed Lord is asked, “Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” Jesus responds by asking the man “What is written in the law?” The man responds by saying that we are called to love God with all our heart, being, strength and mind. We are also called to love our neighbor as ourselves.

“But because he wished to justify himself, he said to Jesus, ‘And who is my neighbor?’” Our Lord then proceeded to tell the story of the Good Samaritan. For the Christian, love of neighbor demands that we care for the hurting and the vulnerable. It means adhering to the Golden Rule so as to treat others as we would want to be treated. Loving our neighbor includes forgiving others and humbly asking others for forgiveness.

Christian discipleship demands a total commitment of self to God and the People of God. As Moses said to the people in the first reading (Deut. 30:10-14) for this Sunday, “If only you would heed the voice of the Lord, your God, and keep his commandments and statutes that are written in this book of the law, when you return to the Lord, your God, with all your heart and all your soul.”

Jesus is the perfect fulfillment of the law. He will help us to love both God and neighbor. Two of the ways he does this is through the sacraments of Penance and Eucharist. By experiencing God’s healing mercy and by receiving Christ himself, we will more readily see Christ in our neighbor and treat our neighbor “with mercy.”
